Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

Carbon Reduction Projects and Current Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2022 baseline and the measures will be in effect when performing the contract. **Obedair has:**

- Electrified the fleet: 40% are electric and the rest are hybrid or petrol. We also offer an electric car scheme for staff.
- Added electric car charging points to office for staff cars.
- Refurbished the office and site cabins to include: more energy efficient LED/PIR lighting) and staff recycling station.
- Accredited by Considerate Constructors on our larger sites – full score of 45/45 meaning we're in the top 2% in the country of Considerate Constructors.

- Collected and analysed waste data at our sites and committed to Waste Reduction Plan (Recycling target of 85% of building products on our sites, currently working beyond that at 90%)
- Current member of Planet Mark, working towards full accreditation to improve our carbon monitoring and reduction.
- Facilitated working from home schedule for staff who live more than 25miles from the office. 40% of office staff regularly work from home to save on travel related carbon.
- Teams Calls are facilitated to reduce unnecessary travel
- 94% of our staff work within 25miles of the office.
- Throughout our supply chain we have reduced road miles of sub-contractors to site by sourcing from local suppliers (within 25mile radius)
- We have ISO14001 certification
